Predator control project (Issue 11 | March 2023)

Kia ora koutou,

We hope you and your whanau have managed to stay safe and dry over the recent wild weather.

If you have been impacted by these events you may be eligible for recovery grants - Links below.

- Individuals, groups, marae, and small business (KDC)
- Farmers/Farms

It's been a challenging summer for all, including our native wildlife, with streams flooding, dunes eroding and forests succumbing to landslides.

This has also made checking traps difficult, with may unreachable and others lost completely. Nonetheless, together we still managed to remove 344 predators over the last quarter, including 51 mustelids, 26 possum, 109 hedgehogs and 132 rats.



We saw a good spike in stoat numbers, catching 25 since December – This really demonstrates the importance of trapping over the summer season.

Remember to record your catch via <a href="Trap.NZ">Trap.NZ!</a>

In exciting wildlife news, there have been reports of Korimako/bellbird spotted along the Mangawhai cliff walk (Bream Tail) recently. These Korimako are likely visiting from the Hen & Chickens, and may even start to recolonise the mainland with ongoing predator control in our community. Wouldn't that be a welcome addition to the dawn chorus.
